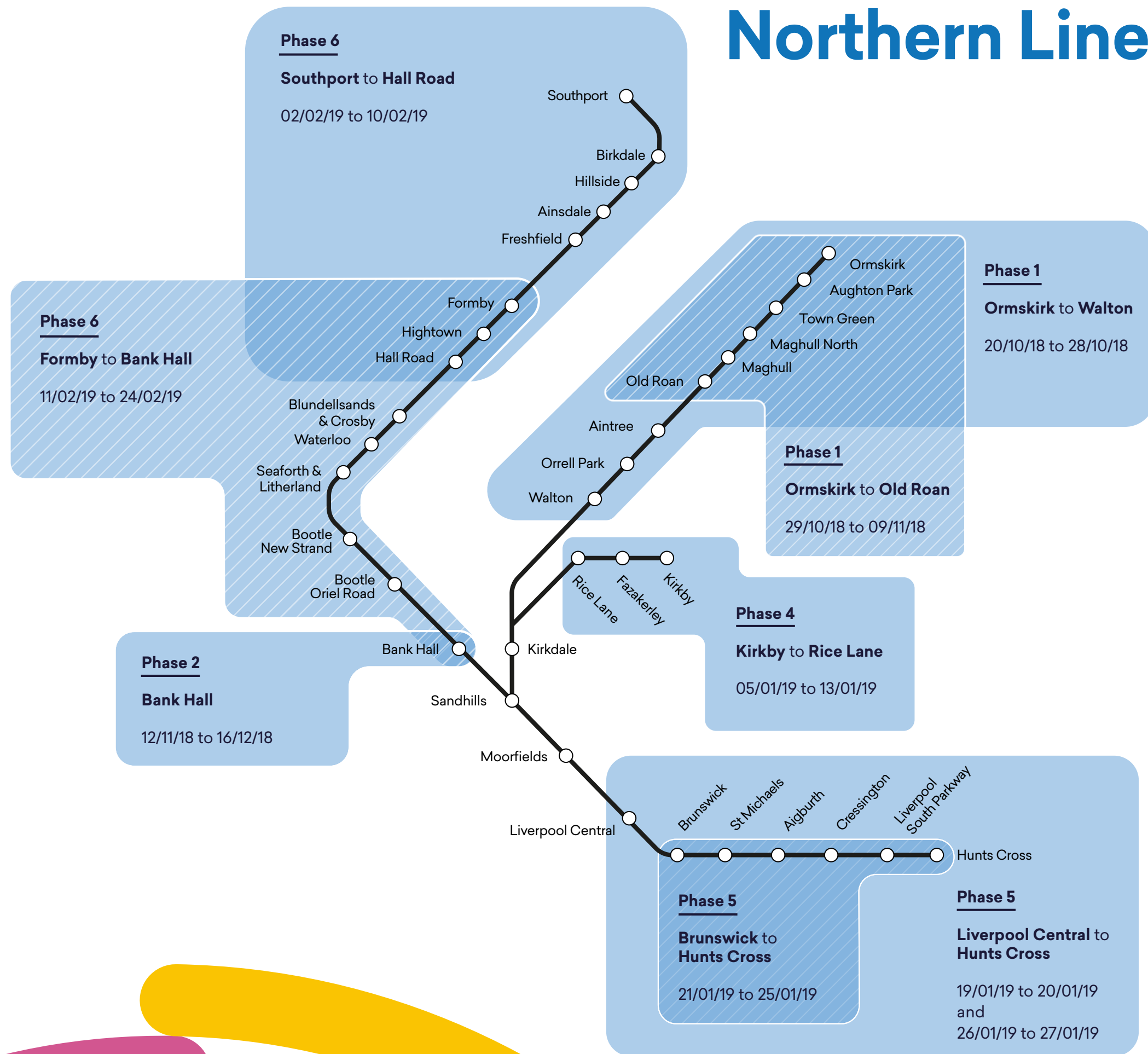


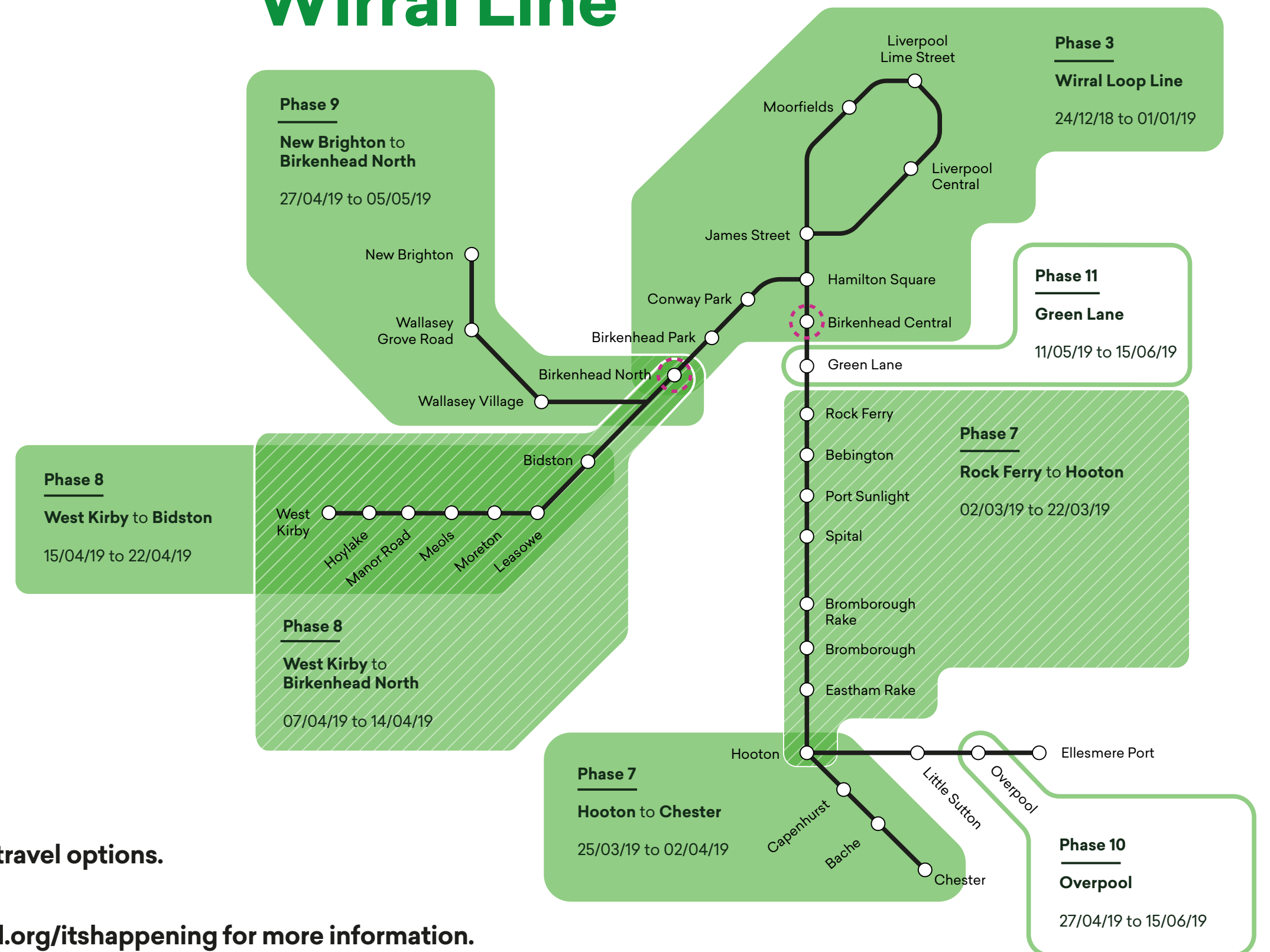
Northern Line

Information about station closures during platform upgrades

Please bear with us

Your brand new trains are on track for 2020 and we need to complete some work to the platforms at our stations to get ready for their arrival. The works will involve station and line closures but rail replacement buses will be in operation.

More information will be released closer to the time of each closure, letting you know exactly how your station and line will be affected and how we will support you getting from A to B. You may see no difference at first, but you'll definitely feel the benefits in the long-run.

Getting you from A to B

We're doing our very best to make sure your journey is as smooth as possible. It's very important to us that while the works are going on, you get to where you need to go with the minimum of hassle, but your journey will need to change. High quality rail replacement buses will get you where you need to go as quickly as possible, some of these will be express services.

- Plan ahead and leave more time for your journeys
- Journeys may take longer especially at peak times
- Check and check again - some timetables may change and there will be closures at different locations at different times on the network
- Stick to public transport
